Entry Criteria

To enrol in this programme, a potential student must:

- › be at least 16 years of age
- › be a New Zealand citizen (or citizen of Australia, Tokelau, Niue, Cook Islands) or permanent resident
- › reside in New Zealand
- › have successfully completed a te reo Māori qualification at Level 2 or demonstrate existing te reo skills and knowledge at Level 2
- › attend an interview or information hui with a kaiako.

Qualification Awarded

When you pass this programme, you'll get this qualification:

- › Te Pōkaitahi Reo (Rumaki) Te Kaupae 3
- › Te Pōkaitahi Reo (Rumaki) Te Kaupae 4

Delivery & Workload

This is a full-time programme that consists of 120 credits delivered over 40 weeks. Some of our locations offer different delivery modes. These will be confirmed by your local campus and might include:

Option 1 (Face-to-face delivery)

- › 2 x 3-hour classes per week
- › 2 x noho marae (26 hours each)
- › 6 x 1-day wānanga (8 hours each)

You'll also need to complete learning activities designed to enhance your learning for approximately:

- › 24.5 hours per week

Option 2 (Noho delivery)

- › 3 hours of class per week (36 weeks)
- › 8 x noho marae (26 hours each)

You'll also need to complete learning activities designed to enhance your learning for approximately:

- › 24.5 hours per week

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Kōnae Ako (Learning Modules)

Mana Tangata 1

15 Credits

This kōnae ako (module) introduces tauira (students) to greeting people and speaking about oneself and others. Tauira will learn to use correct punctuation and common sentence constructions for familiar topics.

Mana Ao Tūroa 1

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will look at current, past and future events. Tauira are then given the opportunity to discuss and understand these topics at length. Tauira will recognise and understand the tense in speech and identify new vocabulary within context.

Mana Tangata 2

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will give tauira the opportunity to ask and answer simple questions using common sentence constructions and recognise and respond to sentences and simple phrases about people.

Mana Ao Tūroa 2

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will look at various types of hui. Tauira are then given the opportunity to write text relevant to a chosen hui. Tauira will learn about relevant whakataukī/kīwaha and use passive and negative sentences.

Mana Whenua 1

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will allow the tauira to recognise and respond to a wide variety of topics relating to whānau. Tauira will then be able to grasp the main ideas of texts and identify relevant vocabulary and understand a variety of questions.

Mana Reo 1

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will give tauira an opportunity to comprehend text on given topics. Tauira will be able to use language related to a particular domain including kīwaha/whakataukī and relevant vocabulary.

Mana Whenua 2

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will give tauira an opportunity to compose short passages and use relevant sentence structures and vocabulary relating to whānau. Tauira will be able to discuss familiar topics with spontaneity.

Mana Reo 2

15 Credits

This kōnae ako will give the tauira opportunity to use extensive sentences, language patterns and vocabulary. This will enable tauira to write effectively using a chosen genre and apply basic rangahau skills to articulate a range of ideas.
